APT Preparatory Activities for WCIT-12

- ❑ **1st APT Preparatory Meeting : 27 May 2011, Thailand**

- ❑ **APT-ITU Workshop on ITRs: 6-8 February 2012, Thailand**
- ❑ **3rd Meeting: 22-24 March 2012, Australia**
 - ⇒ Developed **15 Preliminary APT Common Proposals**
 - ⇒ Submitted to ITU as ACPs (14 June 2012)
- ❑ **4th Meeting: 6-8 August 2012, Thailand**
 - ⇒ Developed **49 Preliminary APT Common Proposals**
 - ⇒ Drafted the **Principles and Criteria** for revision of ITRs
 - ⇒ Submitted to ITU as information (27 Sep 2012)
 - ⇒ **All 49 PACPs become ACPs** with APT Members' support and will be submitted to ITU as ACPs



15 ACPs from 3rd Prep. Meeting

ACP/01	Proposal to systematically replace “CCITT” by “ITU-T”
ACP/02	Replace the tem “Member” by “Member States”, but “Administration” by “Member State” or “OA” considered case by case basis. “OA” used as an umbrella, while ROA/RPOA considered subset of OA.
ACP/03	APT does not support ITU-T or ITU-R Recommendations to be generally referenced as ITU Recommendation in the ITRs
ACP/04	No need to repeat provisions as contained in the CS /CV in the ITR unless such repetition is absolutely necessary
ACP/05	ITU-T Recommendations are non-mandatory and optional/voluntary. No need to modify the Article 1.4 of the ITRs
ACP/06	No need to repeat definitions found in CS/CV in the ITR. New definitions such as “Hub”, “Fraud” and “Spam” may be outside the scope of ITRs
ACP/07	Proposal to add new Article for Network Security
ACP/08	Proposal to add new Article for Number Misuse
ACP/09	Proposal to add new Article 3.6 for Calling Party Number Delivery
ACP/10~15	Modify the final provisions such as Date to entry into force, WCIT has the authority to change ITRs, Editorial revision, Date change, etc.



Principles and Criteria for revising ITRs

□ Principles

1. In the case of inconsistency between the CS/CV/ITRs, CS/CV shall prevail (CS 31 and 32)
2. The Member States are bound to abide by the CS/CV/ITRs and to take the necessary steps to impose the observance of the CS/CV/ITRs upon Operating Agencies (CS 37 and 38)
3. The degree/scope by which a provision in a treaty is binding depends on the languages and terms used.
 - *shall, must, is(are) required* would have mandatory nature
 - *should, may, encouraged, invited, endeavor, shall cooperate* would have non-mandatory nature



Principles and Criteria for revising ITRs

□ **Criteria**

1. Incorporation of the Provisions/Articles contained in the CS/CV in the draft revised ITR
2. Proposals relating to terms and definitions
3. Reference to “ITU Recommendation”
4. Modification to the current structure of the ITR (reshuffling of Articles and/or Provisions)
5. Use of the term “Member State”, “Administration”, “Operating Agency”, “Private Operating Agency, Recognized Operating Agency” and “Private Recognized Operating Agency”
